## Norwegian competence

- Norway is known as «big» nation within fisheries management and aquaculture.
- Norway has a high profile in international fora within fisheries and regulations of marine resources often been in front to secure the environment and sustainability within fisheries and aquaculture
- Norway has common interests with other coastal states, and is regarded as neutral.
- Norway has competence within fisheries management and aquaculture which is demanded by our partner countries.

# Fish for Development (FfD)

- Fishery and aquaculture is higher on the agenda
- Launched August 2015 by Minister for Foreign Affairs Børge Brende
- Secretariate established in Norad 2016
- Interministerial advisory group established (MFA and Min for Investment, Trade and Fisheries) – MFA is making decisions
- VISION: Poverty Reduction
- Impact: The fisheries and aquaculture sector helps promote economic development in the partner countries

# Ffu - options

- Initial focus on bilateral agreements
- 3 main countries for collaboration:
  - Colombia
  - Ghana
  - Myanmar
- Other countries: Angola, China, Indonesia, Mozambique, Pacific, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Vietnam
- Nansen programme
- IUU, Fisheries crime
- In addition development of «modules»
  1. Veterinary services/Fish health
  2. Integrated Ocean Management
  3. Etc.
- Vocational training
- Civil society
- Private sector

## FfD - process

- Request from country, including Concept Note
- Principle discussion within Advisory group FfD
- Mapping process, incl Political Economical Analysis. Status, interface between need in country and where Norway has competitive advantage
- Planning process, developing Project Document – the partner country in charge, support from Norwegian institutions
- Signing of Agreement, implementation can start

# 2018

- Total Norwegian support to fisheries and Aquaculture: 28 mill Euro
- Of these Norad/FfD was responsible for 18, (of which Nansen 13)
- Priority to work with bilateral collaboration + Nansen programme
- IUU and Fish Crime (Interpol, UNODC, PSMA, TMT)
- FAO: (SSF, Climate Change, Biosecurity, PSMA)
- World Bank: ProBlue
- Civil society
- Private sector
- Vocational training
- Food security





# Experiences and Results

- Commitment by all partners, also at high level
- Active participation
- Will and ability to implement and make changes
- Still, very long processes.....
  
- Vietnam
- Norway assisted management, legislation, higher education
- Aquaculture production increased 7,1% p.a 2005-2015
- Gained interest from Private Sector
- Export value almost trippled in same years
